The C Shop Brief Job Descriptions:

1. Clean Up Person

- Sweeping, vacuuming, and mopping
- Sorts and takes out trash, compost, and recyclables
- Cleans all washrooms
- Cleaning machines and equipment
- Moving containers and pieces of equipment
- Cleaning glass (display cases, windows, etc.)
- Other occasional heavy cleaning tasks as arranged
- Sweeping the front porch each night (plus mopping it and cleaning the parking lot when needed)
- Maintains proper sanitation in all work areas
- Asks questions or for help whenever necessary

Hours: Part Time up to 40 hours/week (Night shift variable 10:30pm - 2:30am)

Must be 18 or older.

Beginning wage up to \$12.00.

Two or three people may share this job alternating nights as desired.

Qualifications:

- Must be able to work weekday, weekend, and Sunday nights
- Exhibits strong organizational skills
- Recognizes when help is needed and is willing to ask for it or provide it

2. Baker

- Bakes all products according to C Shop standards and recipes
- Ensures that all baked goods meet quality and presentation standards
- Follows the Kitchen Manager guidelines and direction
- Fills the nightly Bakery Order as directed by 9:30am
- Maintains proper station set up and a clean work area
- Washes and sanitizes dishes
- Current Washington State Food Worker Card

Hours: Approximately 6-8 hours to be complete by 9:30 am. Some shorter shifts of 3-4 hours early in the season and depending on size of order. Orders for the baker are conveyed by 8 pm.

Must be 18 or older.

Beginning wage is \$12.00.

Two or three people may share this job alternating nights as desired.

Qualifications:

- Has extensive experience as a home baker (bread, pie, cookies)
- Has experience troubleshooting yeast breads and a familiarity with preferments and sourdough
- Has a reputation for maintaining a safe and clean kitchen
- Has a familiarity with Baker's Math, HACCP protocols, and SOPs
- Must be able to work weekend and Sunday nights
- Able to lift 50 lb sacks of flour and 40 lb buckets of ingredients

3. Café Crew Member

Café Prep, Sandwich, Pizza Cook, Barista, Server, and Clean up

- Operates the point of sale system and maintains a balanced cash drawer
- Makes all menu items to meet quality, portion, and time standards
- Uses the panini grill
- Makes sandwiches and salads
- Scoops ice cream and makes sundaes, shakes, floats, coffee, tea, cocoa, espresso, etc.
- Uses the bread slicer
- Slices meat, cheese and vegetables for sandwich and pizza prep tables
- Makes pizza dough using a 60qt mixer
- Uses a dough sheeter for pizza dough
- Grates cheeses and make pizza sauces
- Assembles and bakes pizza
- Makes clam chowder
- Prepares baked goods for service and stocks the bakery display
- Packages bread, bakery products, and fills bakery orders as directed
- Washes and sanitizes dishes and uses the dishwasher

- Sorts garbage and recyclables; takes out trash in prep and customer areas as needed
- Assists with general cleaning (sweeping, dusting, scrubbing, emptying garbage, sorting recyclables, etc.)
- Lifts small tables and chairs onto and off of front porch
- Cross trains for Candy Shop work as time allows and need dictates
