Duties:

Our performance expectations are:

- Arrives on time for all shifts
- Makes eye contact and greets guests enthusiastically
- Treats customers and co-workers with courtesy and respect
- Assists with stocking shelves, displays, and supplies
- Follows the Candy PIC guidelines and direction
- Participates in promotions and sales games
- Serves snow cones, cotton candy, and ice cream cones
- Keeps the retail area, display cases, and workstations clean and tidy at all times
- Washes, sanitizes, and puts away dishes
- Assists with general cleaning (sweeping, dusting, scrubbing, emptying garbage, sorting recyclables, etc.)
- Cheerfully assists co-workers with anything that is necessary or requested
- Asks questions or for help whenever necessary
- Finds work to do when slow
- Sorts garbage and recyclables; takes out trash in prep and customer areas as needed
- Picks up yard litter, sweeps front porch and parking areas as needed
- Keeps customer areas clean and organized
- Sweeps, vacuums, or mops floors as needed
- Knows and follows opening and closing procedures
- Directs guests to: seating, washrooms, phone, the Cafe, and Birch Bay attractions
- Positively responds to requests for assistance from co-workers, supervisors, and customers
- Notices when help is needed in all areas of the Candy Shop, takes initiative to help if possible, or lets PIC know where help is needed
- Practices good personal hygiene

We will train you to:

- Weigh and ring up candy
- Operate a point of sale system and maintain a balanced cash apron
- Scoop ice cream
- Package and wrap candy
- Shave ice, make snow cone syrups, and make snow cones
- Make popcorn and cheesecorn (if over 18)
- Make cotton candy sugars and cotton candy
- Wash dishes and use the dishwasher
- Cross train for age-appropriate Cafe work as time allows and need dictates
